

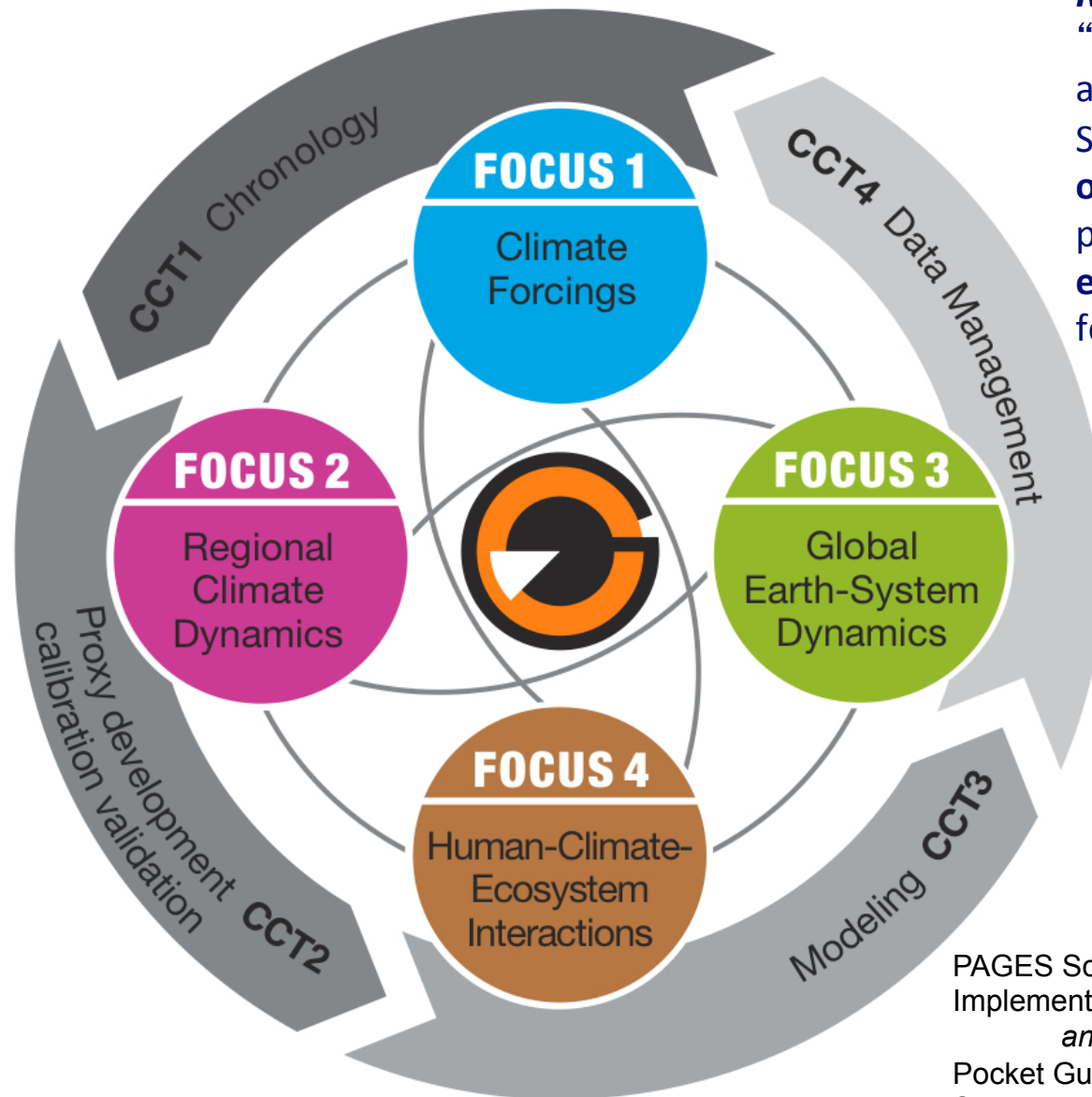

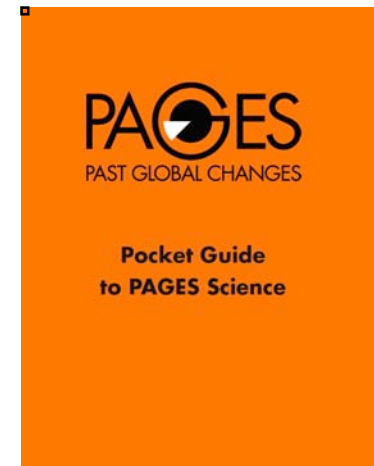
PAGES is ... a paleoscience facilitator

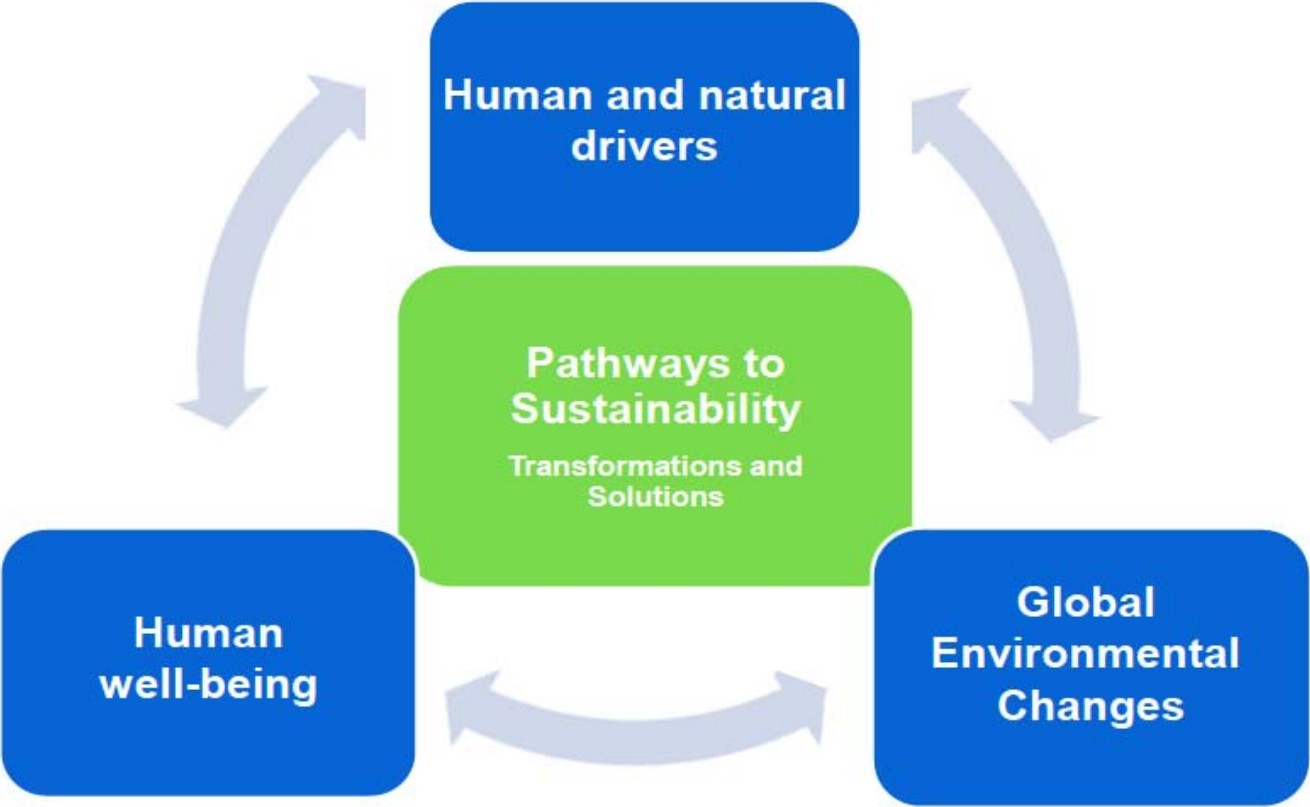

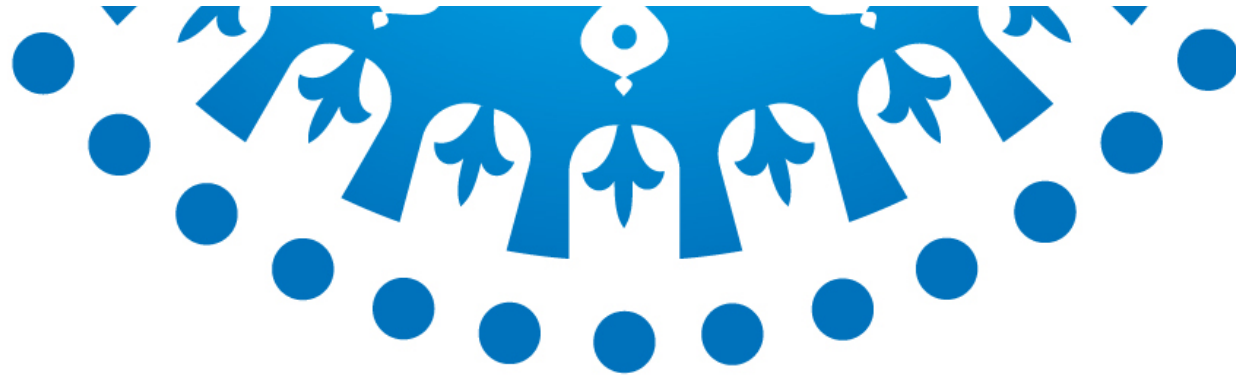
Engage
